Russia invades Ukraine. That's the news headlines, but what does that mean for these end-times, and what does the Christian believer need to know when viewed from a Biblical perspective.

SOC Prison Ministry Update

When I was a young Christian, I was introduced to some very destructive doctrine that devastated my personal prayer life and my ability to hear the Lord's voice. By God's grace, He moved us to Beaumont, Texas, in the mid-seventies, where we attended Victory Temple and Rev. B.H. Clendennen was our Pastor for several years. His influence in our lives set us back on a solid road to serve God and fulfill the call of ministry on our lives.

I began ministry at Bay Correctional Facility in Panama City, Florida, in the mid-nineties, and during that time, we introduced the School of Christ to the men incarcerated there. We had such positive results and conversions that eventually, this was implemented as a critical part of the faith-based program. I was Chaplain there for about twelve years, and I was always amazed at the changes in these men as they progressed through the School of Christ study.

I have attached some of the testimonies I received from staff, volunteers, and inmates of how the SOC has impacted their lives.

Testimony of former Assistant Warden Elizabeth Keys:

It is my pleasure to support the School of Christ program. As Assistant Warden of Bay Correctional Facility, Panama City, FL, from 2007 to 2014, I had the privilege to have this program offered to our inmate population and our Faith-Based dorm during that time. Teaching the gospel, encouraging a daily walk in Christ, and coming alongside each other in that walk is key to a changed heart and changed life. I've seen

many changed lives through this program and wholeheartedly support the gift this is to our population.

Editors Notes:

Among the group of students that made up the first SOC School in Moscow, Russia, in 1992 were Ukrainians. Unknown thousands of ministers and missionaries have graduated from the School of Christ through years.

Founder B. H. Clendennen personally taught the first SOC School in Ukraine, and the leaders and graduates committed themselves to the work of missions. For security reasons, the men of God, graduates of the School of Christ that oversee the work of SOC in Ukraine are referred to as "The Ukraine Brothers." They have a burden for the Ukrainian people and the hungry Christians in closed

countries around them. They have given themselves to taking the Gospel into areas closed to most of the outside world, such as Turkmenia, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, and Kazakhstan. "The Ukraine Brothers" have continuously trained and worked with the SOC since the beginning. The work is going forward, and God is supplying the workers through SOC graduates called of God to be missionaries. God has called us to either GO or SEND, and with your financial help, they were and are able to GO.

According to Christianity Today magazine, "Ukraine has become not just the 'Bible Belt' of Eastern Europe but a 'hub of evangelical church life,

education, and missions.' At present, the country is a crucial supplier of missionaries and is a center of evangelical training and press printing for all the countries of the former Soviet Union." Mission outreach workers need our prayer as they face these most difficult times of war and destruction.

God is still calling young men and women to follow the Great Commission, "Go Ye Into ALL the world and preach the Gospel". Pray God will continue to use these young missionaries and that they will go in His strength and boldness.

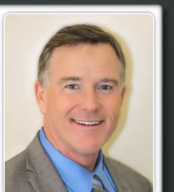
