## **Mexico Report**

The Apostle Paul encouraged the Church of his time and warned us of things that would happen in our time. 2 Timothy 3:1 says, "This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come." The conditions of the world we are living in now tell us we must be more diligent in our work for the Kingdom of God because time is short. Everything is lining up so fast for the new world order, and no time will be left to work.

In August, Richard Goebel, the School of Christ Director, and I traveled to Mexico to check on the SOC work and hold graduation services. We first arrived in Mexico City for a day conference and had a graduation service for the SOC graduates that night. We were greeted by our Fieldworker, Pastor José Ángel Benítez, in Mexico City, who eagerly told us that the work had now spread into the states of Guerrero and Jalisco. The students received us with great joy and enthusiasm, and a group of pastors traveled six hours from Guerrero to be with us at this time of services. The

God spoke to us powerfully as Brother Goebel ministered, showing us in the scriptures what God is doing and is
