

organize a local School for them.

As we prayed about this in the Spring of 2023, a former student contacted us and asked us to come to the country's eastern region where they ministered. She was beginning in the ministry when she attended the SOC in Muron, located in the western part of Mongolia. She was greatly blessed by her participation in the School and wanted to continue actively in the ministry. Now, eleven years later, she is asking the SOC to come to train in her area. Andrey Sekhin, SOC

Fieldworker, and I prayed about what to do as we have several invitations open to us in Mongolia. God led us to commit to Choibasan for a School.

We hoped to have at least 25-30 participants in the Choibasan School, but over 50 showed up to attend. The local churches only have about 20 people each, and we were overjoyed by their response. This is indicative of satan's stronghold in the city. Human trafficking is very strong, and we soon realized that God had sent us here to break the devil's hold on this area.

Ultimately, 14 churches were represented, and over 60 students attended the SOC. Every day, there were testimonies of healing, deliverance, and renewal. Pastors often testified of their struggles and complacency. They testified that God renewed their lives, ministry, and marriages through the teaching of the School of Christ.

Civil War Disrupts SOC In Myanmar

In 2021, the military government came into power. There have been continuous military operations in various parts of the country, military roadblocks,

terrorist acts, and armed clashes. Things in Myanmar changed as we prepared the location where we planned to run an entire SOC School in Rakhine. We purchased bedding and food two days before the start date of the School for the fifteen pastors and fifteen leaders who were enrolled in the School. Civil unrest in Rakhine caused the military to block all cities and roads. Due to the road closures, the supply of food and gasoline stopped. The fifteen pastors were then unable to travel to attend the School.

Despite all the difficulties, we decided to move forward with the SOC School with the leaders from the three churches nearby. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully in the hearts of every student.

The students eagerly listened to the teachings of the School of Christ and were very responsive to the Word of God. We had an hour of individual prayer before and at the end of the day. It was very clear from the first prayer meeting that the students were putting their relationship with God in order that they might receive all that the Lord had in store for them.

At the end of the training, all the students were filled with the Holy Spirit and were determined to preach the Gospel to Buddhists and



Muslims. In the state of Rakhine, there is a very small number of Christians. Buddhism is the most prevalent religion, and a few Muslims. It is so wonderful to see how the Holy Spirit changes and strengthens ministers and workers through the School of Christ.

Thank God we could hold this School despite the war in this state. Thank God that people were inspired to serve the Lord! Thank you for supporting the School of Christ ministry!

Brazilian Pastor & Former SOC Translator Passes Away

It was with heavy hearts that we received news on August 1, 2024, that our friend and Brother in Christ went to be with the Lord. Brother Lisandro Bacedônio served in the capacity as a translator for the SOC in Brazil and Japan alongside Brother Brian Larsen. Brother Lisandro was from the city of Viamão, Brazil, where he was ordained as a Pastor of the Assemblies of God. He graduated from the very first SOC held in

his church in the year 2006, and by 2007 he was already making himself available to travel with Brother Brian Larsen as his translator from English to Portuguese. From about 2007 until 2013, Brother Lisandro remained

an active member of the SOC in South America, being a vital part not only in the translation of the lessons, but also actively working in establishing contacts with Pastors around Brazil and Japan. He also assisted Brother Brian in the paperwork process of obtaining a religious visa for Brazil.

During Brother Lisandro's time of working with the SOC, we witnessed his love for the Lord, the calling and talents that God
